Fashions on the move

TELEVISION shows such as *What Not to Wear* may seem to poke fun at bad dressers but clearly some people do need help in the wardrobe department.

Tucked away in Hoxton Park, Margaret's Place Couture could be the answer for many of the fashionably-challenged.

Sisters Soochen and Soozhee Low travel across Sydney to advise clients on what is their best look and design clothes specifically to match.

Set up 19 years ago by their master seamstress mother Margaret, the decadent fashion service has designed beautiful, individual garments and racked around 300 clients.

"We tailor a particular design to their bodies," design director Soochen said.

"Women nowadays do not have the time so we visit them in their own home or office.

"We bring our fabric with us and advise them on what

suits them or suggest design changes.

"Every step of the way they know what they are getting."

Soochen said she also redesigned clients' own clothes so they could continue to wear them with confidence.

"Fashion tends to be very wasteful and as a sustainable business, we do not like to throw away your old clothes but will look at re-styling and tailoring garments," she added.
